We cordially invite you to join us for our Road Run from the National Mining Museum Scotland, Newtongrange EH22 4QN, via Glenkinchie, to Lennoxlove House EH41 4NZ where vehicles will be on display by kind permission of His Grace the Duke of Hamilton.

The route details will be given out on the day, with different country routes for light vehicles and motor cycles, and another route more suited to the commercials. Cycles start from a site within the Lennoxlove estate.

Full catering is available at the Run start, and at Lennoxlove House coffee/tea, filled rolls etc. will be available from the marquee on the lawn, sponsored by Myreton Marquees. Permanent toilet facilities including disabled access toilets, are located at all venues. Judging is done at Lennoxlove House, and will take into account that vehicles have been driven on the run, with no marks deducted for this.

Please arrive at the National Mining Museum Scotland to register by 9:45am as vehicles will be departing from 10:30 am. If you need space for unloading a large vehicle, it would be useful for us to know in advance to arrange a suitable area. Fuel is available at Tesco, 2 miles north, and Shell 1/2 mile to the South, both on the A7.

Please remember that we are organising this event at our own expense as we will not be able to charge the public for viewing, and we are dependent on the goodwill of these venues to be able to have a Run at all. Please do not contact the National Mining Museum Scotland, Glenkinchie, or Lennoxlove House directly about this event as they will not have full details.

**IMPORTANT:** We have a cap on entry numbers and regrettably may need to decline some entries. The number of vehicles is limited by the capacity of the venues, please only register for this run if you intend to turn up. We appreciate that circumstances can change, as long as you let us know in advance that you are no longer able to come this is not a problem.
